

30 minute circular walk in the countryside around Peasemore from The Fox

From the front door turn right and walk past the common and cricket field. Continue along the road for about half a mile past a water station on the right and past a left turning up ahead. Carry on past the sign to Leckhampstead, the gravel drive and by way on the right.

When you get to the red post box on the left and an impressive pink house on the right, turn left onto the stoney drive that leads down towards some cottages. Walk to the bottom of the drive and at the pretty thatched cottage in front of you step right, into the front garden of the cottage at the side (it is a right of way and a pathway sign is there). Follow the foot path sign so that you walk along the path and across the field, passing (on your left) the thatched cottage with a Shepard's hut in the garden. Walk along the path and up a few tree covered steps into a field and follow the sign (straight ahead) you will see it is a well used path.

At the end of the field is a wire fence, Turn left here and walk along the side of the field until you come to an opening that leads you to a country lane.

You will see the church spire ahead. Turn left and walk straight on following the sign for Peasemore. You will now be walking under a tunnel of trees and at the end of the lane you will come back into the village, with the church on the right.

Turn left at the church and continue past Peasemore Manor on your right. Further on the village hall will be on your left, just after you need to turn left into Hill Green lane and the pub is at the top of the lane on the right.
